Information for Authors

CALL FOR PAPERS

The symposium seeks to explore similarities and differences across the differing attitudes to the special nature of the material 'glass'. We invite papers from a wide spectrum that reaches from the position of individual craft practitioners when faced with the new formal vocabulary inherent in a new manufacturing or making process, to that of a glass technologist seeking to develop a new type of glass product.

Topics may include, but are not limited to the use of new technologies, recycling, the development of personal techniques, the modification of existing processes in the development of specific product designs or architectural features, or the extension of glass through links with other materials and technologies, collaboration with industry.

Papers will be selected subject to a double blind review process by an international review team. In the first instance we ask for the submission of proposals. Authors of selected proposals will be asked to submit full papers.

SUBMISSION OF PAPERS

We invite the submission of proposals by 15 March 2010. Proposals should be 500 words in length, excluding the header and references. The header should contain your name, institutional affiliation, address, email, and the title of the full paper. At the end of your proposal please add 5 keywords. Submissions should be in English language. □

The criteria for selection are:

- Relevance to the symposium theme
- Quality of research presented
- Clarity of presentation

Proposals should be submitted by 15 March 2010 via e-mail to k.niedderer@wlv.ac.uk Proposals should be sent as plain text in the body of the email from the lead researcher's email address.

Authors of selected proposals will subsequently be invited to submit full papers (3000-5000 words) by 20 May 2010. All papers selected for presentation at the conference will be published in the conference proceedings. Papers that do not conform to the required format, however, may not be published.

PUBLICATION

All papers selected for presentation at the symposium will be published in the **conference proceedings** (colour printed booklet with CD), and on the web.
